#### **Staff Training and Preparedness**

Staff, contractors and suppliers have been trained on the safety, sanitation protocols and Duty of Care as per WorkSafe BC Safety Plan. A communicable disease safety plan is in place along with daily wellness checks.

## **Provincial Health Orders**

Events at Victoria Conference Centre are operating at full capacity. We continue to monitor and adhere

to Provincial Government guidelines. There are no restrictions or directives in place at this time.

## **Enhanced Cleaning and Sanitization**

Electrostatic disinfectant is in use as part of our cleaning protocol for our larger spaces.



Continuously Self-Cleaning Surfaces use safe, non-toxic materials to clean high traffic public touchpoints (NanoSeptic), and we have installed additional alcohol-based hand

sanitizing stations.

## Wayfinding and Room Setup

The Victoria Conference Centre's includes attendee flow management for all access routes, queuing space and entrances including transparent shields where required, proper distancing, signage and floor markers. The VCC Events Team are also ready to customize seating capacities and set-up to the needs of the group.

#### **Audio Visual**

Encore Canada, our AV Partner. is educating team members on enhanced cleaning procedures.



Tent cards will indicate equipment has been cleaned with attention to high touch items such as markers, wireless presenters, keyboards and microphones. Close attention to detail around these items that encounter customers, and technicians at the forefront of these enhanced cleaning procedures.

#### Ventilation



The Victoria Conference Centre's HVAC system has been optimized for efficiency. Filters are being changed more frequently and are above industry standard.
